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SHALAKYA TANTRA IN CHAKRADATTA A LITERARY REVIEW

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INTRODUCTION

ABSTRACT

Shalakya Tantra is a branch of Ayurveda which deals with the diseases affecting body parts above Jatrukasthi (clavicle bone) as ear, eye, mouth, nose and head as said by Acharya Sushrita. In present era there is no complete treatise of Ayurveda having detailed knowledge of treatment related to Shalakya Tantra. In this article it is my simple effort to discuss about topics of treatment parts in Shalakya Tantra in Chakradatta.

KEYWORDS: Chakradatta, Shalakya Tantra, Roga, Lakshana and Chikitsa.

Chakradatta is an Ayurvedic treatise being compilation known as 'Chakra Sangraha' or 'Chikitsa Sangraha'. It is a land mark publication of Ayurvedic management by Acharya Chakrapani Datta in 11th century. Acharya Chakrapanidatta is son of Narayana Datta who was a minister and chief of kitchen of king of Gauda. Gauda state is presently a part of West Bengal. He is also younger brother of Bhanudatta who was royal vaidya (physician) of King of Gauda. Acharya Chakrapanidatta is born in a renowned clan of Lodhrabali Datta of West Bengal. Acharya Chakrapani Datta acknowledged Acharya Naradatta as his teacher in Ayurveda Dipika commentary written by him on Charaka Samhita. Other contributions of Acharya Chakrapani Datta are Ayurved Dipika commentary on Charaka Samhita (full), Bhanumati commentary on Sushruta Samhita (Sutrasthana), Vyagradaridra Shubhankara still unpublished, Dravyaguna Sangraha or Dravyaguna published by Acharya Shivadas Sen, Shabda Chandrika by Acharya Priya Vrata Sharma, Sarvasara Sangraha and Muktavali. Commentaries on Chakradatta are Ratnaprabha by Acharya Nischalakara and Chakradatta Vyakhya by Acharya Shivadas Sen. Entire treatise is composed of 79 chapters and 4800

verses. Chapters are divided as per diseases, clinical syndromes, therapeutic procedures and one chapter on preventive medicine and follow order of Madhava Nidana.

LITERARY REVIEW

Kawala dharana procedure for Swarabheda (hoarseness of voice); treatment for different types of Swarabheda (hoarseness of voice) as Vataja, Pittaja, Kaphaja, Medoja, Kshayaja and Tridoshaja; different types of Yogas (formulations) for treatment purposes as Chavyadi churna, Kalitaruphaladi churna, Khadira churna, Ajmodadi churna, Badaripatra kalka leha, Madhuganadi sadhita dugdha, Kantakari ghrita and Bhringarajadi ghrita are described in Swarabheda chikitsa rogadhikara of Chakradatta. Pathya (what to do), Lepa (local applications), Pralepa, Karkaruka Swarasa (extract of cucumber) for Nasya Karma (errhine therapy), Jalakumbhi Bhashma (plant ash of Pistia stratiotes Linn.), Upanaha (warm local application) of Suryavarta (Gynandropsis gynandra Linn.), Galgandahar Jalam, Katphala (Myrica nagi.hook.) powder for gharsana (rubbing), Mandur Bhashma (calcined iron formulation), Shastra Karma (surgical procedure), bilateral post auricular Shiravedha karma (bloodletting procedure), Tumbi taila, Amritadya taila and Brahmanayashtika moola lepa are described for Galganda Chikitsa. Varuna kwath (decoction of Crataeva nurvalaBuch-Ham.), Kanchanar kwath (decoction of Bauhinia variegata Linn.), Aragvadha shifa, Nasya yoga (errhine formulation), Aindri Girikarnika yoga (errhine formulation), Alambusha dala swarasa (plant extract of Sphaeranthus indicus Linn.), Chhuchhundari taila, Shakhotaka Bimbwadya taila and Nirgundi (Vitex negundo Linn.) taila (oil) are described for Gandamala (lymphadenopathy of neck) Chikitsa (treatment). Pupika, Shobhanjanadi lepa, Sharshapadi lepa, Shastra karma (surgical procedure), Dahana karma (Agni Karma), Rekha traya vidhana (Agni Karma), Sahadevi moola (root of Vernonia cineria (L.) Less), Vyoshadya taila, Chandanadya taila and Gunjadya taila are described for Apachi (nodular growth) Chikitsa. Treatment for types of Granthis (knotted growth) as Aama, Vataja, Pittaja and Kaphaja; Haritaki choorna for Paittika Granthi, Vikankatadi lepa for Shlaishmika Granthi, Dantyadi lepa and Dahana (Agni) karma are described for the treatment of Granthi roga. Treatment for types of Arbudas (tumours) as Vatarbuda, Pittarbuda and Kapharbuda; Shastra karma (surgical procedure), Kshar karma (application of Kshar) and Agni karma; Upodika swaras (plant extract of Basella alba L.), Haridradi lepa and Upanaha (warm local application) for Medoarbuda and Swarjikkadi lepa for Arbuda and Granthi rogas are described. Treatment regimens for Oshtharogas (lip disorders) as Vataja, Pittaja, Kaphaja and Medoja; local applications for Oshth rogas (lip disorders), Jalauka applications (leech therapy) for Pittaja,

Raktaja and Abhighataja Oshtharogas; Sarjarasadi lepa for Oshthasphota (cracked lips), treatment for Shitada roga (bleeding gums), Kushthadi choorna for Danta raktasrava (pyorrhoea), treatment for Dantachaala (loose teeth) as Tila (Sesamum indicum Linn.) charvana (chewing) and Bakula twak kwatha (decoction of Mimusops elengi L.); treatment for Dantapupputa (apical abscess), Dantaharsha (sensitive tooth), Dantatoda (toothache), Dantashoola (toothache), Dantaveshta (pyorrhoea), Shushira (chronic gingivitis), Paridar (concurs oris), Upakusha (pyorrhoea alveolaris), Dantavaidarbha (allergic gums), Adhidanta (extra tooth), Adhimamsa (impacted wisdom tooth), Dantanadi (sinus of gums), Dantasharkara (tartar) and Krimidanta (carious tooth); Makshikadi kavala dharana for Dantashoola (toothache), Lodhradi choorna for Dantaveshta (pyorrhoea alveolaris), Lodhradi lepa for Shushir roga (chronic gingivitis), Kakodumbarikadi patra and Pippalyadi kavala for Upakusha (pyorrhoea alveolaris); Pathadi choorna, kavala, nasya and Shirovirechana Dhoompana (medicinal fumes) for Adhimamsa (impacted wisdom tooth); Brihatyadi kwatha for Krimidanta (carious tooth), Vidaryadi taila for Danta Shushira (apical abscess), Apathya (what not to do) for Danta rogas (dental problems), Dronapushpa swaras Karnapoorana and Mustadi tailafor Krimidanta (carious tooth) are described for Lip and dental problems. Treatment for Vataja, Pittaja and Kaphaja type of Jihwakantakas (glossitis); Jihwajadya (numbness of tongue), Adhijihwa (epiglottitis) and Upajihwika (cystic swelling), Vyoshadi choorna and taila for Upajihwa (cystic swelling), Vachadi kashaya kavala dharana and Pathya (what to do) are described for tongue problems. Treatment for Galashundi (uvulitis), Tundikeri (tonsillitis), Adhrusha (palatitis), Koormasanghata (adenoma of palate), Talupupputa (epulis), Talupaka (ulceration of palate), Rohini (diphtheria) and its types as Vataja, Pittaja and Kaphaja, Kanthashalooka (adenoids), Ekavrinda, Gilayu (benign growth) and Galavidhradhi (peritonsillar abscess); general treatment for Kantha rogas (diseases of neck) Kashayas, Kwathas, Kalkas, Choornas, Pippalyadi choorna, Pitaka choorna, Yavagrajadi Gutika, Dashmoola kwatha, Kshar Gutika and Shiva prayoga are described for throat problems.Treatment for Vataja, Pittaja and Kaphaja type of Sarvasaras (stomatitis), Jatipatradi kwatha, Krishnajirakadi choorna, Rasanjanadi choorna, Panchvalkal kwatha, Darvirasakriya, Saptachchhadadi kwatha, Patolladi kwatha, Triphaladi kwatha, Tiladi Gandusha, Mahasahachar taila, Irimedadya taila, Lakshadya taila, Bakuladya taila, Sahakar Gutika, Swalpa Khadiradi Gutika and Brihat Khadiradi Gutika are described for stomatitis and oral thrush type of disorders. Treatment for Karnashoola (earache), Karnanada (tinnitus), Karnabadhirya (deafness), Karnasrava (otorrhoea), Putikarna (chronic suppurative otitis media), Karnanadivrana (auricular sinus), Karnapratinaha (Eustachian catarrh, Karnapaka

(otitis externa), Karnakandu (itching in external auditory meatus), Karnagootha (ear wax), Krimikarna (maggots of ear), Karnavidradhi (abscess of ear) and Karnapali roga (deformity of auricle); Karnashoolaghana preparations as Karnashoolahar yogas, Shobhanjana (MoringaoleferaLam) nirvasa, Ashtamutra (eight types of urine described in Ayurveda for treatment purpose), Ashwatthapatra khalwa yoga, Snuhipatra swarasa, Dipika taila, Arkapatra swarasa, Bastamutra, Bastamutra taila, Hingwadi taila, Kshara taila; Karnanadahar preparations as Apamarga Kshara taila and Sarjika Kshara taila; Badhiryahar preparations as Dasamoola taila, Bilwa taila and Guda nagar Kashaya Nasya; Karnasrava and Putikarna Nashak preparations as Karpasiphalajanya drava, Jambwamra patradijanya drava, Jambwadya taila, Hastiwidjata Gandaka rasa Nirgundiswarasadi yoga, Jatipatrarasa taila, Varunadi taila, Nirgundiswarasadi yoga, Jatipatra rasa taila, Varunadi taila, Rajavrikshadi Jala, Kushthadya taila and Rasanjanadi purana ; Karnanadi vrana nashak preparations as Shambooka taila, Dhusturadya taila; Krimikarna nashak preparations as Krimikarnapaha yoga, Vartaku dhooa, Halimooladi rasa and Krimikarnahar yoga; Shatavaryadi taila and Jivaniyadya taila for Karnapali pushti, Navanita yoga, Vishagarbhadi taila and Mushali kanda for Karnapali vriddhi; treatment for Durviddha karna and Kshinna Karnapali are described for diseases of ear. DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

After going through all the Shalakya related topics of Chakradatta we found that this treatise deals with the treatment part only. Total number of chapters in this treatise is seventy nine having four thousand and eight hundred verses. Chapters follow the diseases order as per Madhava Nidana it means Acharya Chakradatta thought would be to write a treatise that can only deals with the treatment part and not for the aetiological purposes. So persons should follow Madhava Nidana for aetiological purposes and Chakradatta for treatment purpose. One thing can also be expected from this kind of thought is that at the time of Acharya Chakradatta Madhava Nidana would be a famous and accepted to all kind of treatise to understand the aetiological views about the diseases. It may also be possible at that time Madhava Nidana would be simple treatise to learn diseases, so he would thought to make a simple treatise to treat diseases. Surely we can't say anything about which thought may be more correct but we can certainly say that stimulation to make such kind of treatise comes in his mind from Madhava Nidana. Chapters related to Shalakya Tantra are as Swarabheda Chikitsa chapter number thirteen, Arochaka Chikitsa chapter number fourteen, Galagandagandamalaapachigranthiarbuda Chikitsa chapter number forty one, Mukharoga Chikitsa chapter number fifty six, Karnaroga Chikitsa chapter number fifty seven, Nasaroga Chikkitsa chapter number fifty eight, Netraroga Chikitsa chapter number fifty nine, Shiroroga Chikitsa chapter number sixty, Nasyadhikar chapter number seventy four. Dhoomapanadhikar chapter number seventy five, Kavalagandushadhikar chapter number seventy six, Ashchyotana Anjana Tarpana Putapakadhikar chapter number seventy seven and Susthadhikar chapter number seventy nine. Chapters related to treatment part of diseases are scattered, chapters related to Karmas are serially and lastly one chapter is related to Swasthavritta (hygiene).

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
