



REVIEW OF ARSHOGHNA DRAVYA / ANTIHEAMORRHOIDAL DRUGS MENTIONED IN BRIHATTRAYI

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ABSTRACT

Ayurveda plays vital role in curing Arsha [Heamorrhoids] without surgical intervention there are so many herbal drug having Arshoghna property. Many treatment modalities have been explained in Brihatrayi i.e Charak, Sushruta, & Vaghbhata. In Arsha management, the systemic medicines act by improving appetite, regularize bowel habits, astringent action on blood vessels & maintaining Agni & Strotas in equilibrium. Among all the Arshoghna drugs described in Brihatrayi maximum drug are Tikta or Katu or Kashaya Rasa Pradhana & Most of the drug are Ushna in Virya. It can also be said that the drugs having Katu, Tikta, Kashaya Rasa, Laghu & Ruksha

Guna, Ushna Virya & Katu Vipaka play major role in the treatment of Arsha. The review made a humble effort to highlight the ‘Arshoghna Dravyas from Brihatrayi’ as a natural & safe remedy treatment of Arsha.

INTRODUCTION

Ayurveda is a system, which uses the inherent principles of nature to help maintain health in a person by keeping the individual's body, spirit, and mind in a perfect equilibrium.

The term *ayurveda* thus means ‘The knowledge of life’ or ‘science of life. According to the ancient *ayurvedic acharya charaka ‘ayu’* comprises the mind body senses and soul.

According to WHO (1978) "Health is a state of complete physical, mental, spiritual & social well being & not merely an absence of disease or infirmity."

Sharir and *satva* are the *adhishthana* of *vyadhi* (disease). Indian traditional system of medicine, *Ayurveda* encompasses all aspects of living health & sickness. *Ayurveda* is specially known for its natural herbal therapy all over the globe. There is tremendous demand of natural care through medicinal plants for a number of diseases. *Dravyaguna vigyana* is one of major subject of *Ayurvedic* curriculum, hence *dravyaguna* known as soul of *Ayurveda* (*Aatma*).

This subject deals with medicinal plants, described in *samhitas* & *nighantus* in view of pharmacognostical as well as pharmacological aspects (*Gunas*). *Gunas* are main weapon of *chikitsa* therefore we can't do *chikitsa* rather than knowing *Gunas* of *Dravyas*.

Nighantus mentioned *Gunas* of *Dravyas* specifically. So *Rajnighantu* expressed the importance of *Nighantus*. i.e.

Like other pathological conditions *Arsha* has been documented in the *Brihatrayee* i.e. *Charaka Samhita*, *Sushruta Samhita*, and *Ashtanga Hridaya* between 1500 BC & 600 AD.

Present time is the era of changing food, sedentary lifestyle & mental stress, all these factors disturbs the digestive system resulting into many diseases. Among them one important group is anorectal disorders & *Arshas* is one of them.

The word '*Arsha*' is derived from the root '*Ru-gatau*' after adding the suffix '*Asuna*' which means 'to take life'. It is an entity in which muscular projections (*Mansakeel*) troubles the patient like an enemy. The common people call them piles. A pile (pila a ball) is derived from latin. The aristocracy calls them haemorrhoids. The word haemorrhoid is derived from Greek (Haema-blood, Rhoos-flowing) the lay man call them *Mulvyadh/bawasir/komb* etc. *Arsha* have been known to mankind since long time & are one of the commonest disease to affect human beings.

It is commonly seen with those people who having sedentary lifestyle. '*Arsha*' is the gift of busy life style. It has been mentioned one among important disease under '*Ashtamahagada*'. In severe cases, piles may require surgical intervention. *Ayurveda* plays vital role in curing *Arsha* (hemorrhoids) & is explained under *mamsaroga*. Many treatment modalities have been

explained in *Brihatrayee* (*charak, sushruta, & vagbhata*). So *Arsha* is important pathological condition & the study of *Arshoghna dravya* is need of today's modern era to minimize several side effects of modern medicine. Etiopathological chain to develop *Vidhya* (Disease) is called as '*Samprapti*' To break the chain of *vyadhi* that is '*Sampraptibhangha*', we must use *Dravyas* (drugs) having opposite *Gunas*. In *Dravyaguna* there are lots of *Dravyas* which acts as *Arshoghna*.

Treatment principle of piles

Any type of treatment of piles needs strict diet & life style pattern according to one's *prakruti*. Acharya *Charaka & Sushruta* have described four types of treatment for *Arsha*:

1. Aushadhachikitsa
2. Ksharchikitsa
3. Agnikarma
4. Shastra karma

According to Acharya Charaka Aushadha Chikitsa is best for treatment of Arsha. Aushadha treatment of Arsha should be done first & then we may proceed further to Shalya Kriya.

Arshoghna Dravya Gunas well mentioned in various *Nighantus* such as *Dhanvantari, Madanpal, Raj, Kaiyadev and Bhavprakasha*.

Therefore ‘*Arshoghna dravyas*’ were selected in present study from *Brihatrayee* viz. *Charak, Sushrut & Vaghbhata Samhita* & the study was conducted with special reference to their *Gunas* [*Guna, Rasa, Virya, Vipaka & Prabhava*] i.e. *RASAPANCHAKA*. *Nighantus* have described *Gunas* like *Gurvadi Guna* [*Guru, laghu, snigdha, ruksha, etc.*] *Rasa, Vipaka, Virya & Prabhava* etc of *Dravyas* stated in *Samhitas* which is being vastly followed by *Ayurveda* followers. So, it will be of tremendous use to have all references of *Arshoghna Dravyas* from *Brihatrayee*.

These *Arshoghna Dravya* references are being used effectively in *Arsha*. So it will be beneficial to put them collectively to get ready reckoned information for further use & evaluations.

AIM

To compile ‘*Arshoghna dravya*’ w.s.r. to their *Gunas* and evaluate *Arshoghna Dravya* as per types of *Arsha* mentioned in *Brihatrayee*.

OBJECTIVE

- 1) To study *Arshoghna Dravya* in different types of *Arsha*.
- 2) To evaluate different *Gunas* of *Arshoghna Dravyas* from different *Nighantus* and its uses in different types of *Arsha*.
- 3) To study the *Ekal* (single) *Arshoghna Dravya* and in combination.
- 4) To tabulise *Arshoghna Dravya* mentioned in *Brihattryee* and *Nighantus* according to *Gunas* and their expected *Karmukatva* as per types of *Arshas*, and organs.

Study Design

The study conducted is descriptive literary study. *Samhita* and *Nighantus* preferred for the study.



Graph No. 1: Samhitawise distribution of References and Dravyas.



It was observed from the present study that the maximum number of references 112(43.75%) are mentioned in *Charaka Samhita*; then in *Ashtanga Hridaya* 110(42.96%) references mentioned, whereas 34(13.28%) references mentioned in *Sushruta Samhita*.

In case of *Arshoghna dravyas* maximum number of *dravyas* mentioned in *Charaka Samhita* are 199(38.86%); then in *Ashtanga Hridaya* 189(36.91), where as 124(24.12%) *dravyas* mentioned in *Sushrut Samhita*.

Sthanawise distribution of references of Arshoghna Dravyas in samhitas






**Graph No. 5: Sthanawise Arshoghna Dravya References in Ashtang Hridaya.**

DISCUSSION

This study is specially carried out to point out *Arshoghna Dravya* having potential to treat various types of *Arsha*. Number of *Arshoghna Dravyas* references used are scattered in *samhitas* in different *adhyayas*. After defining specific data collection criteria total 256 references are collected from *Brihatrayee*. Among them *Charaka samhita* consists of 112 *shloka* references and 199 *Arshoghna dravyas*; *Sushruta samhita* consist of 34 *shloka* references and 124 *Arshoghna dravyas*. *Ashtanga Hridaya samhita* consists of 110 *shloka* references and 189 *Arshoghna dravyas*. All these references are stated according to *sthanas* and *Adhyayas* from *Brihatrayee*.

The total references and *Arshoghna dravyas* in each *samhita* are presented graphically in observation. The percentage of *Arshoghna Dravya* references in *Charaka*, *Sushruta* and *Vaghbata* are 43.75, 13.28 and 42.96 respectively that maximum numbers of *Arshoghna Dravya* references are mentioned in *Chikitsasthana* of *Brihatrayee*.

Charak Samhita gives *Pippali*(54), *Chitrak*(48), *Sunthi*(47), *Haritaki* (39), *Marich*(32), *Pippalimula*(24), *Kutaj*(26), *Bhallatak*(5) times as a *Arshoghna Dravya* in different references.

Sushruta Samhita gives *Pippali* (13), *Chitrak* (12), *Sunthi* (7), *Haritaki* (9), *Marich* (5), *Kutaj* (7), *Bhallatak* (5) times as a *Arshoghna Dravya* in different references.

Ashtanga Hridaya Samhita gives *Pippali* (60), *Chitrak* (50), *Sunthi* (49), *Haritaki* (31), *Marich* (30), *Kutaj* (18), *Bhallatak* (11) times as a *Arshoghna Dravya* in different references.

Nighantus

The information regarding *Guna*, *Rasa*, *Vipaka*, *virya* is collected from *Dhanvantari Nighantu*, *Madanpal Nighantu*, *Raj Nighantu*, *Kaiyadev Nighantu*, and *Bhaypraksha Nighantu*. So qualities which are not mentioned in *Nighantus* are not stated in tables.

Many of the different *Guna*, *Rasa*, *Vipaka* and *Virya* are noted from the different *Nighantus* for number of *Arshoghna Dravyas*. Comprehensively it can be stated that *Vipaka* or *Virya* of *Arshoghna Dravyas* are not stated in *Nighantus* may have *Samana pratyarabdhavatva*.

Expected Karmukatva of Arshoghna Dravyas:

Dravya dose is karma sometimes by *rasa*, sometimes by *virya*, *Guna*, *Vipaka*, and irrespective of all above *gunas* sometimes *Prabhavaj karma* take place.

It is observed that, of the total drugs mentioned as *Arshoghna Tikta Rasa Dravya* are maximum in number (191) followed by *Katu Rasa Dravya* (159) and *Kashay Rasa Dravya* (147) *Madhura* (129) *Amla* (27) and *Lavana* (4) in number. *Katu Rasa* are *Agnidipana*, *soyathunasana*, *Rochayatiasanam*. *Tikta Rasa* are *Arochkaghna*, *Dipana* and *pachana*. *Kashaya Rasa* are *Ropana*, *sosana*, and *stambhana*. This is indicating that the drugs with *Tikta*, *Katu*, and *Kashaya Rasa* play major role in the treatment of *Arshas*. As *Arshas* is a *raktadoshajvyadhi* and *mamsajvyadhi* it requires *Tikta* and *Kashay Rasa Dravya* to reduce the *Raktdosha* and *Katu Rasa* helps to reduce the *Mamsajdoshas*. They also are *Laghu* and help for treating the indigestion caused in the *Arshas*.

Most of the drugs mentioned are *Usnavirya* in nature (159) and *Sheetvirya* (136) and only a few *Anushana virya* (20) *Ushnavirya* destroys constipation and expels the stools freely and also helps to reduce the haemorrhoids are dry. *Sheetvirya dravyas* help in the bleeding piles for stopping the excessive blood flow.

Madhura (39) and *Katuvipak* (89) *Dravyas* are mentioned to have the property of *Arshoghna.madhura and katuvipakas* can be considered to reduce bleeding piles and dry piles respectively. *Amlavipaka* increases *pitta and raktadosha* there by worsening the disease hence *Amla Rasa dravyas* may not or very few have been mentioned.

Guru (68) *Tikshna* (61), *Laghu* (118), *Singdha* (57), *Ruksha* (91), *Sukshama* (2), *Picchil* (8), other (12) *Gunadravya* are mentioned to be mostly acting on the *Arshas*. *Ksharguna* helps to burn the extra mass formed in the pile mass. *Guru and Tikshnaguna* helps to expel the faeces properly.

In the management of *Arshas*: The systemic medicines act by improving appetite, regularize, bowl habits, astringent action on blood vessels and maintaining *Agni and Strotas* in equilibrium.

From the present study can be said that the drugs having *Katu, Tikta, Kashaya rasa, Laghu, Guru, Tikshna, Ruksha* and *Ksharguna, Ushnavirya* and *Katuvipaka* play major role in the treatment of *Arsha*. As the study is purely theoretical. *Brihatrayee* contains so many references of *Arshoghna Dravyas* like *Jangama, Bhouma (Parthiv)* and *Vanaspatijanya [Audbhida]* but in this study only *Vanaspatijanya Dravyas* are mentioned from *Brihatrayi*.

CONCLUSION

The *Arshoghna Dravyas* references from *Brihatrayee* are numbered as follows.

Charak Samhita

- Total shloka references of *Arshoghna Dravya* are – 112
- Total number of *Arshoghna Dravyas* are - 199

Sushrut Samhita

- Total shloka references of *Arshoghna Dravya* are – 34
- Total number of *Arshoghna Dravyas* are – 124

Ashtanga Hridaya Samhita

- Total shloka references of *Arshoghna Dravya* are – 110
- Total number of *Arshoghna Dravyas* are – 189

Total number of references [*shloka*] of *Arshoghna Dravya* found in *Brihatrayee* is – 256. Total number of *Arshoghna Dravyas* in *Brihatrayee* is – 230. *Pippali, Sunthi, Haritaki, Kutaja, Bhallatak* are used most commonly as an *Arshoghna dravya* in *Brihatrayee*.

Nighantus

Nighantus have mentioned *Guna, Rasa, Vipaka* and *Virya* of *Arshoghna Dravyas*. *Nighantus* have not described all the qualities in together in shloka of *Arshoghna Dravyas*.

Among these 230 *Arshoghna Dravyas*

- In *Dhanvantari Nighantu* total 191 *dravyas* are mentioned with *Gunas* of 44%, *Rasa* of 89%, *Vipaka* of only 7% and *Virya* of 84% *Arshoghna Dravyas* are mentioned.
- In *Madanpal Nighantu* total 201 *dravyas* are mentioned with *Gunas* of 69%, *Rasa* of 63%, *Vipaka* of only 12% and *Virya* of 85% *Arshoghna dravyas* are mentioned.
- In *Raj Nighantu* total 192 *Dravyas* are mentioned with *Gunas* of 28%, *Rasa* of 97%, *Vipaka* of only 5% and *Virya* of 82% *Arshoghna Dravyas* are mentioned.
- In *Kaiyadev Nighantu* total 221 *dravyas* are mentioned with *Gunas* of 74%, *Rasa* of 98%, *Vipaka* of only 35% and *Virya* of 87% *Arshoghna Dravyas* are mentioned.
- In *Bhavprakasha Nighantu* total 215 *dravyas* are mentioned with *Gunas* of 68%, *Rasa* of 93%, *Vipaka* of only 19% and *Virya* of 82% *Arshoghna Dravyas* are mentioned.

The *Gunas* of *Arshoghna Dravyas* described by *Bhavapraksha Nighantu* resembles more appropriate to their *Arshoghna karma* advised by *Brihatrayee*.

Further Scope of Study

The *Arshoghna Dravya* references from *Brihatrayee* are the basis of simple but important approach beneficial and cost effective *Ayurvedic* treatment. These references will be pioneered to evaluate important uses and benefits of these *Arshoghna Dravyas*. Researchers will have ready reconed information for the research activity on *Arshoghna Dravya*.

The *Nighantu* references will be beneficial to recapitulate the qualities of *Arshoghna Dravyas* and to review their uses stated in *Samhitas*. Also these references will be guest met in a ruling out the controversies. The detailed pharmacological and clinical study will evaluate the specific mode of action of *Arshoghna Dravya* in various type of *Arsha*.

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
